We are excited to bring our members, partners and clean energy experts together to celebrate the CEM's 15th anniversary through a packed agenda including 50 side events and roundtables, as well as new announcements including the launch of new CEM initiatives. CEM15 discussions will centre around opportunities for collaboration to implement concrete actions needed to make clean energy affordable and accessible to all and accelerate the clean energy transition worldwide.

This year's Ministerial meeting will run in parallel to the 4th G20 Energy Transition Working Group (ETWG) meeting, with CEM Ministerial discussions happening just before the G20 Energy Transition Ministerial Meeting, allowing for deeper engagement and collaboration across the CEM and G20 communities. We are excited to see those of you attending in person and encourage the rest of our community to follow the action on our <u>LinkedIn</u> and <u>X</u> accounts.

Some expected outcomes include:

- Recognition of CEM award winners: The CEM Energy Management Leadership awards, Equality in Energy Transitions awards, Hydrogen TCP awards and the ISGAN Awards of Excellence will recognize their 2024 award winners.
- A call to action on power systems solutions: Power sector workstreams will
 come together to address key investment challenges such as flexibility,
 storage, electric vehicle infrastructure and regulatory frameworks through a
 formal call to action.
- A Statement of Actions to accelerate low and zero emissions 'future fuels': A coalition of CEM workstreams and partner organisations will work together to outline concrete actions to accelerate the use and production of low and zero emissions fuels.

CEM at 15 Years




