

## Highlights from Foz

We are one week on from the CEM15 in Foz do Iguaçu and we are happy to say it was a resounding success, thanks to the collective efforts and dedication of the CEM community! The impressive turnout of over **1,000 high-level delegates**, more than **50 technical and high-level side events** - including numerous ministerial sessions - and **40+ strong outcomes** underscored CEM's role as a powerful platform for global collaboration, knowledge sharing, and advancing clean energy deployment.

A key highlight was the endorsement of a [Joint Ministerial Statement](#), reaffirming member countries' commitment to work collaboratively through CEM to advance clean energy goals. This underlines the importance of the CEM as a platform for action-oriented cooperation to achieve ambitious goals set by political fora. The [G20 Ministerial Outcome Statement](#) further underscored this importance by highlighting the role of the CEM in strengthening cooperation among G20 members and accelerating energy transition goals globally.

CEM15 delivered many tangible outcomes, such as a [Call to Action for Power Systems Solutions](#), a [CEM Action Plan to Accelerate Future Fuels](#) and an [Implementing Inclusivity framework](#). These concrete outcomes demonstrate the value of the CEM as an implementation platform in support of political ambition-setting fora such as the G20 and COP processes. Other key outcomes from CEM15 included the launch of new CEM workstreams on [Carbon Free Energy](#) and [Sustainable Lifestyles](#), as well as a joint CEM and MI [Gt by 2030 Campaign](#). These new initiatives will contribute significantly to achieving global clean energy goals and promoting a more sustainable and equitable future.

CEM15 also marked the [15th anniversary of CEM](#) and provided a unique opportunity to celebrate CEM's achievements to date and to set ambitious goals for the next decade. On this occasion, members reaffirmed the value of CEM's flexible, action-oriented approach and also recognised the central role of the Secretariat in supporting the CEM community, with many member countries pledging financial contributions.

We are also pleased to announce that active planning is already underway for next year's [CEM16 Ministerial Meeting in 2025 in the Republic of Korea](#). More updates on the CEM16 will be announced in the coming months.



## CEM15 Outcomes

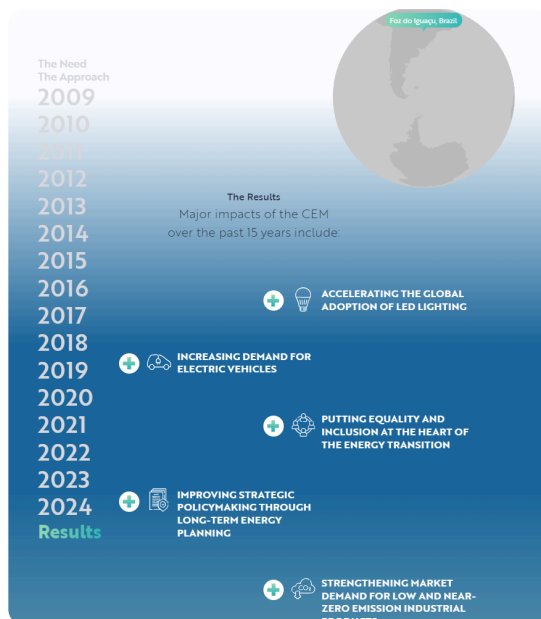
This year's Ministerial meeting resulted in over 40 outcomes from CEM workstreams, members, and partners.
